

EDGEWOOD ISD MEAL CHARGE POLICY

Edgewood ISD has established a charge policy for students who do not have money on their account or did not bring money to pay for breakfast or lunch.

Students may charge a total of five (5) meals.

Student will receive an alternate meal after the fifth charge. The alternate meal will consist of:

- Vegetable
- Whole grain
- Fruit
- Choice of milk

Charge letters will be sent home once a week.

After a student charges two (2) meals, a charge letter will be sent home.

After a student charges four (4) meals, a charge letter will be sent home.

When a student reaches five (5) meal charges, a phone call will be made to the guardian.
