This is only a pre-registration. All students will still be required to complete registration at the beginning of the school year. This preregistration allows us the opportunity to collect all required documents before the school year begins and prepare for the coming school year.

In order to complete the pre-registration process, you must complete the pre-registration form and also must submit ALL of the required documentation items.

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Does my child qualify for PreK?

To be eligible, a child must be at least four years of age by September 1 of the current school year, reside within the district, AND meet at least one of the criteria listed below.

- Be unable to speak and comprehend the English language
- Be educationally disadvantaged, which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program;
- Be homeless, as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1143a
- Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority;
- Be the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States who was injured or killed while serving on active duty;
- Be in, or have been in, the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code;
- Be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer (3106.002), firefighter (3106.003), or emergency medical first responder (3106.004).
